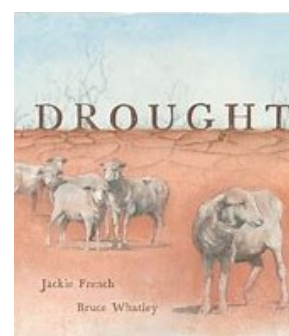
3-6 News

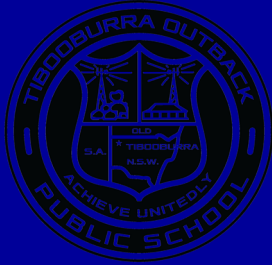
