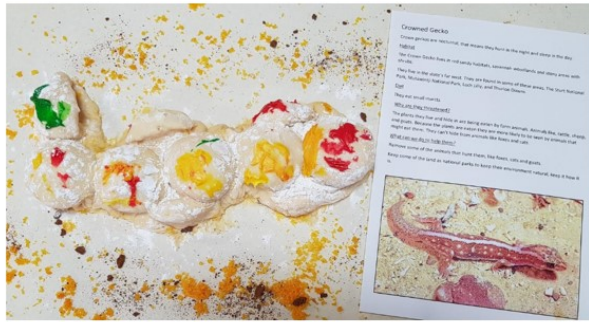
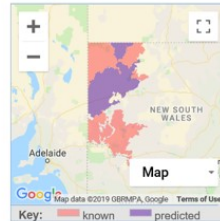

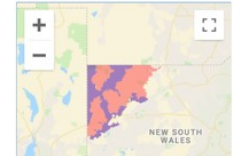


Fat Tailed Gecko

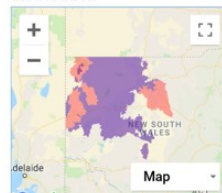


Stimson's Python
